## A self-care guide for dressing changes

## How to apply the Mextra® Superabsorbent dressing:

- 1. Wash your hands with soap and warm water for 20 seconds.
- **2.** Clean the wound as advised by your nurse.
- **3.** Apply Mextra Superabsorbent directly on the wound area with the white side of the dressing onto the wound. Blue side up!




- **4.** The pad should overlap the dry surrounding skin.
- **5.** Fixate the Mextra Superabsorbent dressing e.g. with a suitable bandage or tape given to you by your nurse.
